SDAP IS A DISCRETIONARY MONETARY INCENTIVE PAID TO ENLISTED SOLDIERS WHO QUALIFY FOR AND SERVE IN DESIGNATED SPECIAL DUTY ASSIGNMENTS, THAT HAVE EXTREMELY DEMANDING DUTIES REQUIRING EXTRAORDINARY EFFORT FOR SATISFACTORY PERFORMANCE OR AN UNUSUAL DEGREE OF RESPONSIBILITY. THIS ALARACT DETAILS CURRENT SDAP ALLOCATIONS APPROVED BY THE ASSISTANT SECRETARY OF THE ARMY (MANPOWER AND RESERVE AFFAIRS) (ASA (M&RA)), IN ACCORDANCE WITH REFERENCES 1.I. AND 1.B.

3. THE BELOW SDAP ALLOCATIONS ARE APPROVED BY THE ASA (M&RA), REFERENCE 1.B. THE ARMY WILL COMPLY WITH ADMINISTRATIVE AND REGULATORY POLICY TO ENSURE COMPLIANCE WITH THIS ALARACT AND MEMORANDUM.

4. IN ADDITION TO THE MILITARY OCCUPATIONAL SPECIALTY (MOS) AND ASSIGNMENT CERTIFIED MEETING THE CRITERIA FOR SDAP, SOLDIERS ARE ONLY ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE SDAP WHEN THEY MEET ALL OF THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS IN ACCORDANCE WITH REFERENCE 1.E.:

4.A. ARE ON ACTIVE DUTY AND ENTITLED TO BASIC PAY UNDER SECTION 204 OF REFERENCE 1.H. OR IS A RESERVE COMPONENT SOLDIER ON INACTIVE DUTY TRAINING AND ENTITLED TO COMPENSATION UNDER SECTION 206 OF REFERENCE 1.H.

4.B. ARE SERVING IN PAY GRADE E-3 OR HIGHER.

4.C. HAVE COMPLETED THE SPECIAL SCHOOLING/TRAINING REQUIRED FOR QUALIFICATION IN THE SPECIAL DUTY ASSIGNMENT.

4.D. ARE CERTIFIED AND ACTUALLY SERVING IN AN AUTHORIZED DUTY ASSIGNMENT DESIGNATED FOR AWARD OF SDAP. THE AWARDED OF, OR RECOMMENDATION TO INCREASE, AN SDAP LEVEL WILL NOT BE BASED ON THE SOLDIER'S PERFORMANCE OR ABILITY OF A SOLDIER TO ACCOMPLISH AN ASSIGNED TASK OR PRODUCTION QUOTA.

5. TO ENSURE COMPLIANCE WITH AUDIT READINESS STANDARDS, COMMANDERS AND SERVICING PERSONNEL OFFICES WILL ISSUE FORMAT 330 (PROFICIENCY PAY) ORDERS PRIOR TO AWARDED, CHANGING, TERMINATING, OR REINSTATING SDAP. FORMAT 330, (REFERENCE 1.G.), ORDERS WILL SERVE AS THE SUBSTANTIATING DOCUMENT FOR SUPPORTING ARMY MILITARY PAY OFFICES.

6. COMMANDERS WILL CERTIFY THE ANNUAL AND BIENNIAL SDAP REVIEW AND APPOINT A PROGRAM MANAGER TO SERVE AS A LIAISON WITH THE DCS, G-1 IN ACCORDANCE WITH REFERENCE 1.H.

7. THE DCS, G-1 WILL COORDINATE WITH THE DEFENSE FINANCE AND ACCOUNTING SERVICE TO SUSPEND SDAP PAYMENTS IN THE ABSENCE OF CERTIFICATION DOCUMENTATION AND ISSUE NECESSARY GUIDANCE TO ENSURE PROPER PROGRAM OVERSIGHT IN ACCORDANCE WITH REFERENCE 1.A.

8. THE ARMY AUTHORIZES PAYMENT OF SDAP FOR THE FOLLOWING SPECIAL DUTY ASSIGNMENT PROGRAMS IN ACCORDANCE WITH REFERENCE 1.A.:

8.A. NOMINATIVE COMMAND SERGEANTS MAJOR/SERGEANTS MAJOR ASSIGNED IN THE ACTIVE COMPONENT (AC), ARMY NATIONAL GUARD (ARNG) AND THE U.S. ARMY RESERVE ARE AUTHORIZED SD-1, SD-2, SD-3, OR SD-4 BASED ON THE RANK OF THE RATER'S DOCUMENTED POSITION AS LISTED IN THE MODIFICATION TABLE OF ORGANIZATION AND EQUIPMENT/TABLE OF DISTRIBUTION AND ALLOWANCES (MTOE/TDA).

8.B. THE SERGEANT MAJOR OF THE ARMY; THE SENIOR ENLISTED ADVISOR TO THE CHAIRMAN OF THE JOINT CHIEFS OF STAFF; AND THE SENIOR ENLISTED ADVISOR TO THE

CHIEF, NATIONAL GUARD BUREAU (WHEN THE POSITION IS FILLED WITH AN ARMY ENLISTED MEMBER) IS AUTHORIZED SD-6.

8.C. THE OLD GUARD, TOMB OF THE UNKNOWN SOLDIER, SOLDIERS ARE AUTHORIZED SD-3.

8.D. THE OLD GUARD CAISSON PLATOON SOLDIERS ARE AUTHORIZED SD-3.

8.E. NATIONAL GUARD, WARRIOR TRAINING CENTER SOLDIERS ARE AUTHORIZED SD-2.

8.F. CRIMINAL INVESTIGATION DIVISION (CID) SPECIAL AGENTS ARE AUTHORIZED SDAP AT THE FOLLOWING LEVELS:
