Ms. Ileen F. Rogers is the director, Army Continuing Education System Department of the Army, Alexandria, Va. Within the Department of the Army, the Army Continuing Education System (ACES) through its many programs and services promotes lifelong learning opportunities. It also supports the Army Campaign Plan that states, "Support for Soldiers, civilians and their families is a critical part of the Army's ability to defend our Nation." In her position, Ms. Rogers brings together The ACES organization which consists of three headquarters offices (education division, reserve and national guard), Installation Management Command (IMCOM) Head Quarters and seven regional offices, 102 active Army education centers and satellite sites and 139 active Army Multi-use Army Learning centers, 16 reserve education offices at regional readiness commands, and 54

national guard state and Commands, Army-wide. She is ultimately responsible for the development, implementation and execution of a \$343 million budget for the Total Army (active and reserve components).

Ms. Rogers a native of Orangeburg, S.C., is the second of four children. She earned her Bachelor of Science in psychology from the University of South Carolina at Columbia and Master of Education from South Carolina State University, Orangeburg. She holds a Certificate of Advanced Graduate Studies in Human Resource Education and Development from Boston University, Mass., and is a graduate of the American University Institute for the Study of Public Policy Implementation, Washington, D.C.

Her Washington, D.C. assignments were Group Manager for Training and Executive Development within the Strategic Human Resources Policy Division, U. S. Office of Personnel Management (OPM) and Assistant Director, Leadership and Education, Internal Revenue Service. Previous assignments include Director of Education Program and Services, U.S. Navy, and Chief, Education Services Division, III Corps and Fort Hood, Texas. She has been an ACES regional director, education services officer, education services specialist and guidance counselor. In addition to Washington, D.C., her stateside assignments include Forts Gordon, Ga., and Hood, Texas and the Naval Support Activity, Millington, Tenn.. Ms. Rogers was also assigned in Europe.

Ms. Rogers has received several awards throughout the years including the Superior Civilian Services Award, distinguished graduate of the Army Management Staff College and recipient of the Internal Revenue Service Commissioner's Award.
