Permanent Promotion Recommended List Overview:

The Soldiers listed on the Headquarters, Department of the Army (HQDA) PPRL contains Soldiers who are currently promotable and have been **integrated** onto the promotion standing list **through the PPW application**. Promotable Soldiers are Soldiers who have been recommended for promotion by a promotion board or Soldiers who are MLI. These Soldiers have also meet the eligibility criteria outlined in AR 600-8-19, table 3-1. Soldiers who are **NOT** listed on the HQDA PPRL **have not** been integrated onto the promotion standing list through the PPW and they **WILL NOT** be considered for promotion. As outlined in MILPER Message 20-218, all Soldiers must be integrated through the PPW for promotion consideration. It is the responsibility of the **Soldier**, the **unit HR Specialists, and unit commanders** to ensure promotable Soldiers are **integrated** through the PPW application. A **failure** to integrate a Soldier onto the promotion standing list within the prescribed timeline is **NOT** grounds for promotion reconsideration. Furthermore, this failure is **NOT** a system error. The PPRL is revised and distributed every month to capture new data and allow promotable Soldiers access to view what is reported to the HRC, Military Schools Branch (MSB) and the HRC, AGR Force Alignment Division (FAD), such as the Soldier's promotion point scores. Promotion point scores may vary from what listed on the PPRL and what's listed on the Soldier's PPW. Although a variance exists, the promotion point score that is listed on the PPRL is what's being report to MSB and FAD. The PPRL displays the Soldier's correct promotion point score.

Army Training Requirements and Resource System (ATRRS) Overview:

Due to contracting issues with ATRRS, the PPW does not reflect a Soldier's complete military education record. Until this contract is finalized and the PPW is given access to legacy military education records for AGR Soldiers, Soldiers who need to have their resident military training and correspondence course hours updated in their PPW, **MUST** contact their unit HR Specialist. Readiness Divisions will review, validate, consolidate, and process Individual Soldier military training requests to HRC, Junior Enlisted Promotions. These Soldier requests will be processed in accordance with the established USARC G1 processing procedures.

The military education updates report will be submitted by Readiness Division to HRC, Junior Enlisted Promotions and processed in accordance with the established USARC G1 processing procedures.

Soldiers MUST contact their unit Human Resources Specialist and/or immediate chain of command for all questions and issues regarding their personnel records. Unit HR Specialist MUST contact their Readiness Divisions for assistance and guidance.

HQDA AGR SGT Permanent Promotion Recommended List (PPRL)

The following Soldiers are on the Headquarters, Department of the Army (HQDA), PPRL (standing list). Promotion point totals are as of **7 November 2022**. Soldiers must **meet** or exceed the cutoff score for promotion selection in their primary military occupational specialty and have structured self-development/ Distributed Leader Course **level one completed**. Soldiers listed with an asterisk are not graduates of the Basic Leader Course Noncommissioned Officer Professional Development System (NCOPDS). This list is updated on or about the 26th of every month. The RRC/DRC/MACOM/RD/USAREC must update appropriate systems to ensure the PPW is updated no later than the 26th of the promotion board month. Any questions concerning this list should be directed to your RD, RRC, DRC or MACOM/immediate chain of command.
